Setting Up Your First Location

After logging in, you will be directed to the *Account Summary* Screen. It is shown below. So set up a new location, click "Add Location" link.



Configure

See Configuration Screen below.

Get Code

Generates HTML/PHP code that you can copy & paste into your website in order to filter your images through the CatchLock stamping service.

Cache:

For faster performance, the images.catchlock.com server stores a copy of frequently accessed images. This performance boost is particularly significant for images using the *Sledge Etch* stamping algorithm. Cache is cleared automatically. The only time when you should manually clear the cache is if you modified any pictures on your server.

<u>Delete</u>

Deletes the location. Please note that logos associated with the location are not be deleted.

Configuration Screen

Domain:

Server name where your images are strored. Do not include http:// or trailing slash.

e.g: www.diesel-software.com

Directory

The directory on the server where images are stored. Do not include preceding or trailing slashes.

e.g: catchlock-pass/protected_images

Authorization

If the above directory is password-protected, enter the username and password that is required to access the images. Select an authorization type:

- None: username & password are ignored
- Basic: directory is protected with HTTP Basic method
- Digest: directory is protected with HTTP Digest method

Please note that custom log-in forms are not supported.

Logo Position

If you'd like to stamp your images with a logo, select the location by clicking on the appropriate radio button.

Logo Margin

This specifies, in pixels, how close to the edge of the image the logo is to appear

Visible Fingerprint

You can specify font, font size, font color and background color (see *picking colors* below). In order for the visible fingerprint to be shown, the visible algorithm must be selected (see *Fingerprinting Algorithms* below)

Picking Colors

Clicking on the large colorful area picks the hue. Slider on the right enables you to select brightness. Slider on the bottom allows you to select transparency level and also displays the currently selected color. You should see the numeric value of the corresponding color change as you change the color.

Preview Mode:

Determines how the images will be displayed to users who are not logged in:

- None: message requesting the user to log in is shown
- **Lowres**: Images are pixilated (blurred with squares). They are shown in full size but at a lower resolution 160x120).
- Sample: "Sample" is written all over the image

Fingerprinting Algorithms

Select the visible and invisible algorithms which you'd like to use for fingerprinting your images.

Mass-Download Protection

Someone might try to steal your images by using an auto-download program (several images are accessed in short amount of time) or by manually saving contents of your website (large number of images accessed over hours or days). You can enable mass-download protection to receive warnings and/or to automatically ban the user. Recommended numbers:

Max of 40 images in 60 seconds

Max of 180 images in 7200 seconds (2 hours)

Selecting a Logo

You can upload your own logo or select one from the predefined CatchLock logos. To upload a new logo, simply click on the Browse button and select the appropriate file. For transparency/glow/shadow effects, your logo must be in the PNG file format with alpha channel specifying transparency. To not display any logos, select the "No Logo" box. To delete a logo, click on the red X in the right-upper corner of the logo box.

Configuring your Website

The Catchlock website generates HTML / PHP code that you can copy & paste into your website in order to filter your images through the CatchLock stamping service before they are shown to the viewer. Simply click on the "Generate Code" button in the Account Summary Screen.
